FOCUS: Jesus, our path to salvation, calls us *brother* and *sister* and commands that we do the will of God.

LITURGY OF THE WORD: In Genesis, sin enters the world as Adam and Eve yield to the serpent's temptation. Paul's Letter to the Corinthians urges believers not to be discouraged: our earthly dwelling fades, but life in the Lord is eternal. Mark's Gospel shows Jesus being described by the scribes as "possessed." Jesus responds with a promise that doing the will of God makes us his brothers and sisters.
