We share with them the generous, voluntary donations to the Saint James poor boxes (which are located on either side of the Broad Street main door entrance to our lovely church building). Since January, and through June, we have distributed approximately \$15,000 dollars of help to those in need for such things as rent/emergency housing (which consumes the largest amount), electric bills, gas bills, food, and sometimes miscellaneous items such as medicine. We have provided furniture (obtained at no cost) which one of our members has transported at his own cost. We donate our time sometimes to take someone grocery shopping or do it for them, give them rides, etc. When we mail food cards or checks, we all use our own stamps & envelopes, etc.; the business office allows us to use their fax machine, etc. So, incredibly, our overhead is exactly nothing at all. Thank you for your continued prayers for us, and for those we serve with the help of your donations.
